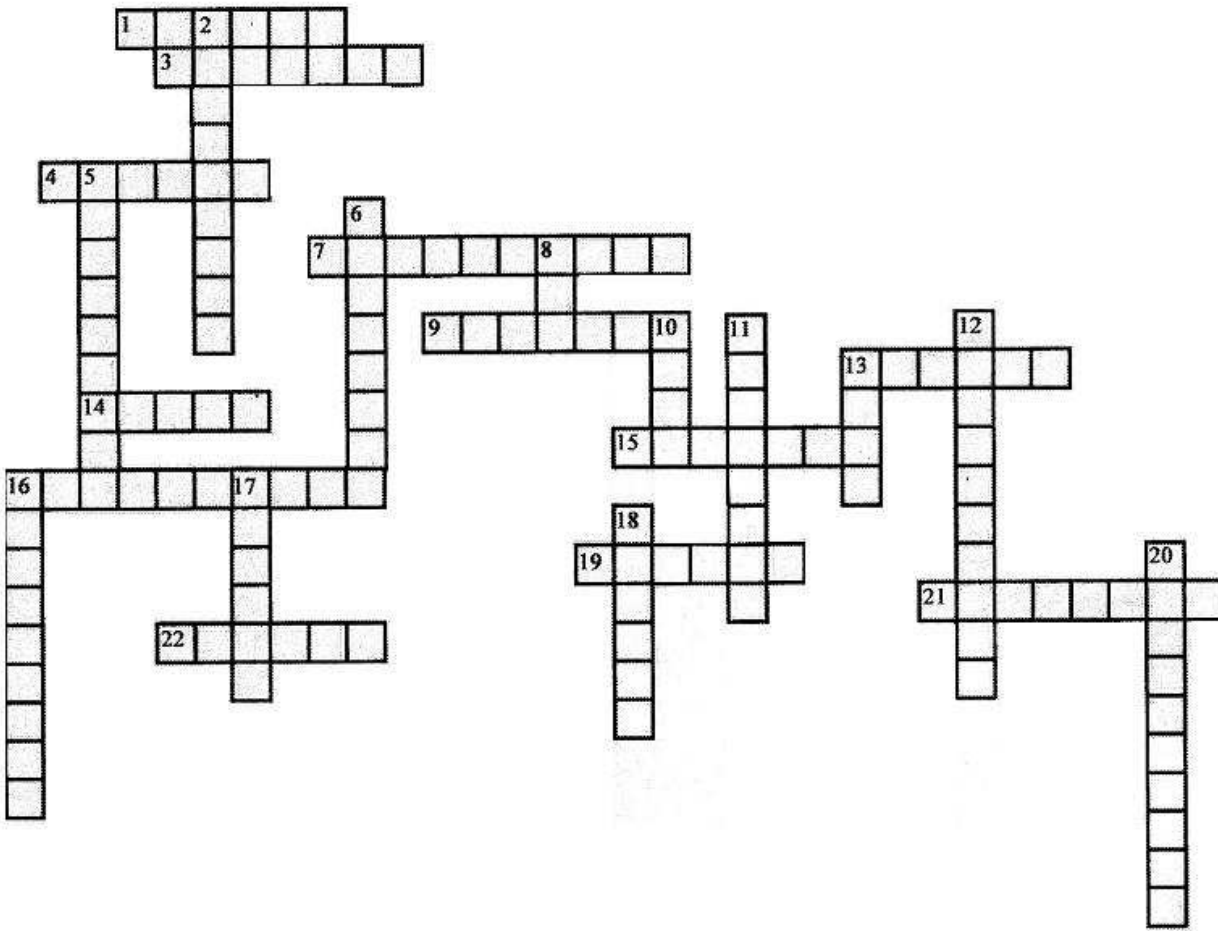


## CROSSWORD: SPORTS
